The Psalms help us do at least three things:

- Pray on all occasions with all kinds of prayers (Ephesians 6:18)
- Rejoice always, pray without ceasing, & give thanks in all circumstances (1 Thess 5:16-18)
- Identify with Christ, who prayed the Psalms

At times, we all lack wisdom.

The wisdom Psalms help us pray for God's vision to become our vision.

What is a wisdom Psalm?

A Wisdom Psalm is a sacred Hebrew poem focusing on the general results of a righteous and/or unrighteous direction in life.

Psalm 91

"In the whole collection there is not a more cheering psalm; its tone is elevated and sustained throughout, faith is at its best and speaks nobly." -Charles Spurgeon

i will (91:1–2): i- the author

- Trust the person of God (1-2)
- Trust the care of God (2)

You will (91:3–13)

- Expect protection (3-8)
- Experience protection (9-13)

I will (91:14–16):

- Protect my children (14)
- Answer my children (15)
- Give life to my children (16)
