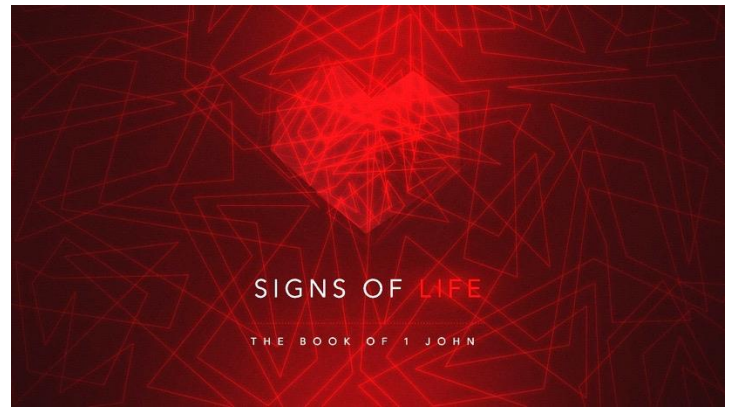

2. **Head to the app or website** (wildwoodtlh.com/give) to set up your new giving account and gift. Once you provide your info the first time, you shouldn't need to add it again unless you need to change it.
